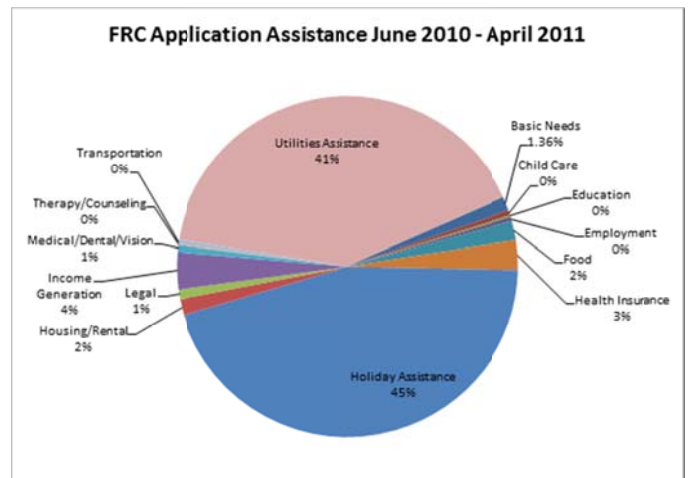


Basic Needs and Public Benefits Support and Access

Since the mid-year report the Children’s Network and the Family Resource Centers continue to work on finding ways in which to support families’ basic needs and access to public benefits. Over the course of the last fiscal year July 1, 2010 – April 30, 2011 3,461 applications were submitted totaling \$487,426.31. In addition, during this same time period, 3,244 referrals were made totaling \$73,600.24. A breakdown of these applications, by category, is presented in the charts below.
